Every summer, parishes throughout the Diocese of Brooklyn participate in a mission appeal to help us learn about evangelization efforts that are taking place around the world so we can support them both financially and with our prayers. We are happy to welcome Bishop Nicholas DiMarzio to St. Luke this weekend. He will speak to us about the Diocese of Our Lady of Deliverance of the Syrian Eparchy and the work that they do to bring the Good News of Jesus to the faithful. There are no envelopes for this collection, so the ushers will go through the church a second time so that we can generously support the missions.

FORMED has a series on Mary that has been recommended. There are 8 videos of about ½ hour each that will cover the following topics: The New Eve; The New Ark; Mother of the Messiah; Queen Mother; The Perpetual Virgin; Mother of Sorrows; The New Rachel; Questions and Answers. This video series is available to all parishioners on the FORMED platform, but sometimes it’s beneficial to experience the videos with others to gain insights and inspiration that you might not get on your own. On the last Mondays and Thursdays of August at 7 PM we will show these videos in the Monsignor Tosi Pastoral Center, and all are welcome. If anyone plans to come and would like to provide cold drinks or snacks for those evenings, please let me know.

While I haven’t gone through the Bible to count for myself, I have read multiple times on social media that the words, “Be not afraid” appear in the Bible 365 times. I did a little Googling and it seems that the actual number is less than that. In today’s Gospel passage from St. Luke’s 12th chapter, Jesus says, “Do not be afraid any longer, little flock.” Following up from last week’s passage, Jesus encourages his disciples to store their treasure in heaven. While we might not be able to locate a year’s worth of daily Bible passages telling us to not be afraid, we know that, as long as we remain close to the Lord, we have no reason to fear, for He loves us and will always protect us.

In terms of saints this week, we celebrate St. Clare on Monday. St. Clare lived in Assisi during the time of St. Francis, and, with his guidance, formed a religious community of sisters, The Order of Poor Ladies, which followed a rule of strict poverty. If you visit Assisi, a Basilica dedicated to St. Francis is located on one side of the town, and another dedicated to St. Clare is on the other. The legacy of these two great saints has endured for almost 800 years. On Thursday, we celebrate another saint in the line of St. Francis of Assisi: St. Maximilian Kolbe. He was a Polish Conventual Franciscan friar who offered his life in Auschwitz during World War II in order to spare the life of a husband and father who was to be put to death.

On Friday, we celebrate the Solemnity of the Assumption of Mary, a holyday of obligation. Mass will be celebrated on Thursday evening at 7:30 PM, and on Friday at noon. Join us as we celebrate this wonderful celebration of our Blessed Mother!
