The weeks are passing quickly. Back to school sales dominate the ads on radio and tv. We've had the last 8:00 PM sunset until next May. Labor Day is September 1st, and classes begin again later that week. Enjoy the slower days of summer while they last, and we ask God's blessing upon all of us as we prepare for a new pastoral year. I extend a special thank you to those who have "Adopted a Classroom" for the upcoming school year!

Bishop Chappetto and I are hitting milestone birthdays this week. On Wednesday, Bishop Chappetto will turn 80 years of age. Thank God he is still active and able to assist our parish and other communities when the need for coverage arises. On Thursday, I will turn 62, which means that I am old enough to start collecting Social Security! I remember my dad when he turned 62 – he was the happiest man in all of Flushing because he was able to retire from the pharmacy at Flushing Hospital. While Uncle Sam might allow retirement at 62, Holy Mother Church expects priests to remain in active ministry (health permitting) until at least 72. We ask for your prayers, that God will continue to bless us with good health so we can continue to exercise our priestly ministry for many years to come.

On this 20th Sunday in Ordinary Time, we are struck by the message that Jesus shares with his disciples: "I have come to set the earth on fire, and how I wish it were already blazing! ... Do you think that I have come to establish peace on the earth? No, I tell you, but rather division." We often think of Jesus is a man of peace and love and compassion and mercy. To hear him speak in this way can be unsettling. However, the Good News that He came to preach isn't a passive message. As his followers, he wants us to be on fire with the gospel, which means that sometimes those around us will not be ready to change their hearts and their lives when we share the gospel with them. We need to do so anyway!

Over the next two weeks on Monday and Thursday I will present a video series on Mary in the Monsignor Tosi Pastoral Center at 7:00 PM. The 8-video series is available on FORMED, so you can watch the program at any time. However, sometimes it is good to join others for an experience of faith formation so we can learn from one another and be inspired together as we explore the many biblical titles of the Mother of God. We will watch 2 videos each night (about an hour) and then have an opportunity to discuss the material. Let's be honest ... every night you watch tv and complain that "there's nothing on!" Join with other parishioners for something worthwhile and inspirational.

Last Friday we celebrated the Assumption of the Blessed Virgin Mary on August 15th. This coming Friday, August 22nd, the Church celebrates the Queenship of Mary. These two Marian feasts, celebrated one week apart, are the final mysteries of the Glorious Mysteries of the Rosary. We ask the Blessed Mother to watch over our parish and to intercede for us.
