You will remember that St. Carlo Acutis was canonized along with St. Pier Giorgio Frassati on September 7th during this Jubilee Year. Typically a “feast day” is chosen for saints after they are canonized, and today, October 12th, is the first feast day of St. Carlo Acutis, who died on this date in 1996. The feast day of St. Pier Giorgio also marks the day of his death: July 4, 1925. As we remember St. Carlo today, we recall his great devotion to the Eucharist, which he called his “highway to heaven.” Parents and grandparents are encouraged to foster a devotion to St. Carlo as you pray for his intercession for your children and grandchildren. Bring the young people of our community to the statue of St. Carlo at the back of the church and remind them that he had many of their experiences with sports and technology, but he also made his relationship to Jesus, especially in the Eucharist, his number one priority. We entrust the young people of our parish to this newly canonized saint: St. Carlo Acutis, pray for them!

Just a reminder that the Family Mass will return next Sunday at 10:30 AM at the request of St. Luke School parents. Of course, all parish children are welcome, and I pray that this will begin a renewal of the regular practice of the faith for parish families. A Catholic school makes no sense if children are not regularly coming to church with their families, and I look forward to seeing many families at Mass every week.

Next weekend will be busy here at St. Luke. On Friday, the Knights of Columbus are hosting a Pasta Night at 6:00 PM. On Saturday, we will celebrate a Mass for the Anointing of the Sick at noon in the Monsignor Tosi Pastoral Center. After all Masses next weekend we will host the Bethlehem Olive Wood sale to help support our Christian brothers and sisters in the Holy Land. On Sunday morning, the Youth Group will host a Pancake Breakfast. Thank you for your support and participation in these special parish events!

For our gospel this weekend we turn to the 17th chapter of Luke’s gospel for the story of the healing of the lepers. The beautiful stained-glass window by the organ depicts this episode. Ten lepers called upon Jesus and asked to be healed. They kept their distance because, as lepers, they were expelled from the community. Jesus sent them to the priests because only a priest could declare them healed and restore them back to the community. On their way, they were cleansed of their leprosy, but only the Samaritan returned to Jesus to express his gratitude. This gospel passage is often used at Thanksgiving and certainly is a reminder to all of us that we need to express our gratitude to Jesus when He answers our prayers.

The Italian Apostolate of the Diocese of Brooklyn will gather at St. Mel for its annual Mass. Bishop Brennan, Bishop DiMarzio, and Bishop Chappetto will concelebrate the Mass, and Italians from Brooklyn and Queens will participate in the celebration. On Monday, we celebrate Columbus Day. The rectory office and St. Luke School will be closed, and Mass will be celebrated at 9:30 AM.



-Hail, Holy Queen, Mother of Mercy, our life, our sweetness and our hope.

To thee do we cry, poor banished children of Eve: To thee do we send up our sighs, mourning and weeping in this valley of tears. Turn then, most gracious advocate, thine eyes of mercy toward us, and after this our exile show unto us the blessed fruit of thy womb, Jesus.

1. Make the Sign of the Cross.

2. Holding the Crucifix, say the Apostles' Creed:
-I believe in God, the Father almighty, Creator of heaven and earth, and in Jesus Christ, his only Son, our Lord, who was conceived by the Holy Spirit, born of the Virgin

The Baptism of Christ in the Jordan

"After Jesus was baptized, he came up from the water and behold, the heavens were opened, and he saw the Spirit of God descending like a dove coming upon him. And a voice came from the heavens, saying, 'This is my beloved Son, with whom I am well pleased.'" - Matthew 3:16-17

he descended into hell; on the third day he rose again from the dead; he ascended into heaven, and is seated at the right hand of God the Father almighty; from there he will come to judge the living and the dead.
