This weekend is marked by the feast of our parish patron, St. Luke, who is celebrated every year on October 18th. Our stained-glass window highlights that he is a writer of the Divine Word. The angel of the Lord speaks to him, and he has a pen in one hand and paper in the other so that he can faithfully transmit both his gospel and the Acts of the Apostles. St. Luke is often symbolized with a winged ox or bull – a figure of sacrifice, service, and strength. St. Luke teaches us that as Christians, we should be prepared to sacrifice ourselves in following Christ. Both of his New Testament books are written to Theophilus, a name that means Lover of God. By reading and reflecting on Luke’s gospel and the Acts of the Apostles, we come to know more about Jesus, which leads us to a deeper loving relationship with our God. Saint Luke, pray for us!

We are in the final weeks of “Year C,” and so we will continue to hear from Luke’s gospel on Ordinary Time Sundays until Advent. Today, from the 18th chapter, we hear the parable of the dishonest judge and the persistent widow. The widow simply pleads for a just decision against her adversary; while the judge is inclined to be dishonest in his decisions, he opts for a just decision because of her persistence and because he feared that she would strike him if he were unfair! Jesus uses the parable to teach that, while human judges might take their time in executing justice, God will make sure that his chosen ones receive justice speedily.

As we gather for Mass this weekend, the world is celebrating the efforts to bring about peace in the Holy Land. Hostages have been returned to their families, agreements were signed, and hopes are high that rebuilding can begin. Our friends from Bethlehem are here this weekend to sell olive wood religious articles to help support the few remaining Christians in the Holy Land. While some articles are reasonably priced, the purpose of the sale is to allow us to generously and charitably sustain brother and sister Christians who have suffered greatly over many years of war and oppression. I thank you for your kind support. While you go to the Pastoral Center to see the religious articles, you can enjoy a Pancake Breakfast to help support our parish youth group.

Next weekend Bishop Brennan is leading a diocesan pilgrimage to the National Shrine of the Immaculate Conception in Washington, DC. Our neighboring parish, St. Paul Chong Ha-Sang, has seats available on their bus, so if anyone is interested you can call them to reserve a seat so you can participate in a wonderful event for the Jubilee Year.

Our parish will once again host Early Voting this year, beginning next Saturday. I thank you for your patience and understanding as our Pastoral Center is made available to our community so citizens can vote for the upcoming elections. I know many parishioners enjoy the convenience of being able to vote either before or after coming to Mass. I encourage everyone to vote!

I’ll be away on retreat this week at Mount Saviour Monastery in Elmira, New York. Oremus pro invicem ... let us pray for one another!


Note: If you wish to color these pictures, it's best to color them before you assemble the mini book.


3: Stack the folded strips together in the correct order.
