This weekend we turn the calendar page to November. November 1st is All Saints Day, and each year we are given the opportunity to remember all those who embraced the message of the gospel and lived a life of virtue and grace. As Catholics, we believe that the saints are in heaven and can intercede for us. As a parish we call St. Luke our patron saint, but individuals and families foster devotion to particular saints like the Blessed Mother, St. Joseph, Padre Pio, St. Jude, the Little Flower ... and even more recent saints like St.

Carlo Acutis or St. John Paul II. **All holy men and women ... pray for us!**

Today, November 2nd, is All Souls Day, and the whole month of November is a time for Catholics to remember the faithful departed. Since November 2nd falls on a Sunday this year, it takes the place of the 31st Sunday in Ordinary Time. The sadness and grief we experience at the death of a loved one is personal and real. Certainly our faith can be a great comfort to us, and we appreciate the love and support of family members and friends. On Saturday, November 22nd at Noon we will celebrate a Mass for all those whose funerals were celebrated here in our parish since last All Souls Day. **May they rest in peace.**

The Parish Center has been very busy all week with Early Voting. Election Day is Tuesday. St. Luke is NOT a voting site for Election Day; Early Voting concludes here at 5:00 PM today (Sunday). I certainly encourage everyone to vote!

As you may remember, I began my assignment here at St. Luke in 2020. My first weekend at the parish was in July - the first weekend Masses were celebrated in church after COVID. I was formally installed as pastor by Bishop DiMarzio on the feast of St. Luke. Pastor assignments in the Diocese of Brooklyn are typically for 6 years, so I will be up for renewal in June of 2026. I am certainly happy here and will seek to be renewed. The process for renewal includes evaluations by staff and a few random parishioners, as well as a self-evaluation that I will submit to the bishop. Normally, the vicar for the region oversees the process; since I am the Regional Episcopal Vicar of Queens East in addition to being pastor of St. Luke, the bishop will ask one of the other vicars to oversee the process. I pray that God will watch over and bless our parish always, and, if it is His will, that I be renewed as pastor for another six years. I ask your support and prayers as this process begins.

We will hold our second Novemberfest celebration next Saturday. Last year was a lot of fun with good food and a live band providing music, along with a dance troupe that includes our own Mrs. Mezic, the assistant principal of St. Luke School. Please purchase your tickets as soon as possible and plan on joining us for a wonderful fall event.


