Following All Souls Day last weekend, we have another special celebration this weekend: the Feast of the Dedication of the Lateran Basilica in Rome. A basilica is a designation for churches around the world with special privileges granted by the Vatican because of historical, architectural, and spiritual significance. There are four major basilicas, all in Rome: St. Peter, St. Paul Outside the Walls, St. Mary Major, and St. John Lateran. The Diocese of Brooklyn is home to three minor basilicas: the Cathedral Basilica of St. James, Our Lady of Perpetual Help in Sunset Park, and Regina Pacis in Bensonhurst. With regard to today's feast, we celebrate the church that serves as the Cathedral for the Bishop of Rome, Pope Leo XIV. Of course, we associate St. Peter's and the Vatican with the Successor of St. Peter, but Vatican City is its own country. Rome, as the capital of Italy, is associated with the Pope because, in addition to being the Vicar of Christ on earth, he is the Bishop of Rome. The celebration of the dedication of the Pope's Cathedral is significant for the universal Church, since we are all united to the Pope as members of the Catholic Church.



As you know, Hurricane Melissa was devastating to many people in Jamaica, the Dominican Republic, Haiti, and other countries in its path. Thank God hurricane season is officially over, but many people in the Caribbean will rely on the generous response of many people to rebuild and restore their lives. Bishop Brennan has asked parishes to consider taking up a special collection to send assistance to those in need. We will take up a collection here at St. Luke on the weekend of November 22/23. If you would like to donate online, you can use this QR code to make an offering through Give Central.

Tuesday is Veterans Day, which gives us the opportunity to honor those who proudly served our country in the military. At the 11th hour of the 11th day of the 11th month in 1918, the Armistice with Germany went into effect, bringing an end to World War I. Armistice Day was renamed Veterans Day in 1954, and distinct from Memorial Day, which honors those who died while in military service, Veterans Day commemorates and honors the service of all US veterans. The rectory office will be closed, and Mass will be celebrated at 9:30 AM instead of at 12:00 PM. Please join us at Mass to honor our parishioners who valiantly served our country in the military.

On Thursday this week, we celebrate the memorial of St. Frances Cabrini, also known as Mother Cabrini. The center stained-glass window in the transept by our organ honors this great woman who came to New York to help serve the needs of the poor Italian immigrants who were struggling to make a new life for themselves in America. Her feast gives us the opportunity to pray in thanksgiving for our own ancestors who came to this country generations ago, and the many first generation of immigrants who still live among us here in Whitestone. We pray that new generations of immigrants will continue the great legacy of enriching our society with their contributions while striving to achieve the American dream for themselves and their families.







Because the church is made up of many different Christian people, Paul compares it to a building made up of many different materials and put together by many workers.






