We are back to Ordinary Time on this 33rd Sunday. As we come to the end of the liturgical year, the gospel challenges us to reflect on the “end times.” Jesus warns that alarming things will occur, but he says, “Do not be terrified.” He also warns that we will need to give testimony, but He will provide us with the wisdom we will need to respond effectively. He encourages us to persevere, and so we rely on Word and Sacrament to keep us close to God so we can remain faithful disciples.

Next Saturday at Noon we will celebrate a Mass for all our deceased parishioners of the past year. Families are invited to bring photos (up to 8x10) for tables that will be set up by the altar. We entrust our loved ones to the mercy of God, and we pray that God will comfort and console all those who mourn.

I remind parishioners that you may want to express your final wishes to your family so they will respect your desires when you pass away. While we celebrate around 100 funerals in a given year here at St. Luke, we are occasionally also asked to lead prayers at the funeral home without a funeral Mass. Regarding cremation, the Church allows for a funeral Mass either before or after cremation. The Church teaches that cremains should be treated with the same dignity as the body, which means that they should be interred either in the ground or in a columbarium, which is a niche designed to hold an urn or receptacle that contains cremains. Our parish website has a page to assist parishioners in planning their funerals, including all the options for readings and hymns, as well as guidelines for eulogies and other ways for family members to participate in the liturgy. You might also think of updating your estate plans if they were prepared a long time ago. Please consider remembering St. Luke and the Diocese of Brooklyn in your estate planning.

Next weekend is the last weekend before Thanksgiving. Every year we collect food to share with several communities to help families provide a proper celebration for the holiday. Please be generous and bring non-perishable food items that we can easily distribute to families in need. We will also take up a collection to help the victims of Hurricane Melissa which devastated Jamaica and several other countries in the Caribbean. As we anticipate the celebration of Thanksgiving here in Whitestone, we recognize how truly blessed we are with all that we have been given by God. This time of year allows us to make a return to the Lord for all the good He does for us.

On Wednesday at 7:30 PM Bishop Chappetto will celebrate a special Mass for survivors of cancer and those who are currently coping with cancer. We will borrow a relic of St. Peregrine from Sacred Heart Parish in Bayside, and we will distribute prayer cards of the patron of those struggling with cancer, AIDS, and other life-threatening illnesses. Please spread the word and plan on joining us for this special celebration.
