Today the Church celebrates the Solemnity of Our Lord Jesus Christ, King of the Universe, formerly known as Christ the King. Today's solemnity ushers in the final week of the current liturgical year. Next weekend, with the first Sunday of Advent, a new liturgical year will begin, and our readings will come from "Cycle A," which focuses on the Gospel of St. Matthew. Perhaps the onset of a new liturgical year will give you a reason to consider some spiritual resolutions for the new year. Some might consider more faithfully practicing the faith

by coming to church every Sunday and holyday of obligation. Others might wish to pray more regularly, taking on a commitment to pray the Rosary or the Liturgy of the Hours every day. Perhaps you have considered getting involved in the parish by joining the choir or becoming a lector or Extraordinary Minister of Holy Communion. Our nation will pause this week for our annual celebration of Thanksgiving. What I love about this holiday is that it implies a national belief in God, since who else deserves our thanks but our Creator God and Father? This year I have asked Bishop Chappetto to lead us in prayer on Thanksgiving Day as we celebrate Mass at 9:30 AM. As usual, you are invited to bring a food item from your table for a blessing that will extend to the entire meal and the family gathered together in Thanksgiving. I am grateful to all of you for your love and support of all the clergy and staff of St. Luke. May God bless all of us as we celebrate Thanksgiving! Just a reminder ... the rectory office will be closed on both Thursday and Friday this week, and the daily Mass on both days will be at 9:30 AM ... there will be NO NOON MASS on either Thursday or Friday this week.
