I pray that everyone had a blessed and happy Thanksgiving. Whether you travelled a bit or stayed local, I hope you enjoyed spending time with family and friends, and that your time together was an opportunity to recognize your many blessings. We are grateful to all those who had to work on Thanksgiving, and we certainly care for those who spent the holiday alone or who marked the first Thanksgiving since the passing of a loved one. I want to thank everyone for your generous response last weekend. Volunteers helped to collect and sort the food that was distributed to several communities to provide needy families with the provisions for a proper holiday meal to share with their families. We also took up a collection to help the victims of Hurricane Melissa in Jamaica and other parts of the Caribbean.

On this final weekend of November, we begin a new liturgical year with the First Sunday of Advent. In terms of the 3-year cycle of Sunday readings, we return to “Year A” with a focus on the gospel of St. Matthew. The gospels of Matthew, Mark, and Luke are known as *synoptic gospels*, which means that they contain similar content and follow a similar outline. Scholars believe that all four gospels were written in the first century, though there is debate regarding the exact order. Matthew’s gospel is written with a Jewish audience in mind, and so the author presumes the audience doesn’t need explanations about Jewish traditions. Today’s passage comes from the 24th chapter with a focus on our needing to be prepared: “for at an hour you do not expect, the Son of Man will come.” As we light the first candle of the Advent wreath, may we carry the light of faith with us so that we can keep our focus on Jesus as we renew our commitment to follow Him.

Next weekend we will have the annual celebration of the lighting of our parish Christmas tree. Our Youth Choir will sing at the 4:30 PM Mass on Saturday, and they will join us outdoors as we pray together before the lights adorn our tree and nativity scene. On Sunday, both the Adult and Youth Choirs will inspire us with Advent hymns that will help us in our spiritual preparation for Christmas. Remember, too, that on Tuesdays after the noon Mass, Sr. Theresa and Mary Pollini lead a Scripture faith sharing to help us reflect on the Sunday readings during this holy season. These are busy and joy-filled days, and I am grateful to everyone who works behind the scenes to make these celebrations so special for our community.

Keep in mind that Reconciliation Monday will be a week earlier this year: on Monday, December 15 we will have priests available for confession immediately after the noon Mass for as long as we are needed. In the evening, from 7:00 to 9:00 PM, we will have Eucharistic Adoration while priests are available for confession. Among all the other preparations during Advent, don’t neglect to give the spiritual gift of forgiveness to yourself so that can clearly follow the light of hope that will lead us to celebrate the Nativity of Jesus.


