On this Second Sunday of Advent we hear the voice of the Baptist: "Repent, for the kingdom of heaven is at hand! ... Produce good fruit as evidence of your repentance." While we focus on repentance in a special way during Advent and Lent, it really should be a way of living for us as disciples of Jesus. We often fail, we often fall, but the Lord, in His mercy, picks us up and gives us the grace we need to try again and to produce good fruit as evidence of our efforts to be faithful to the

gospel. Stay awake! Stay alert!

Tomorrow we celebrate the Solemnity of the Immaculate Conception, a holyday of obligation. Mary is our patroness under this title both in the Diocese of Brooklyn and also nationally in the United States of America. The Immaculate Conception celebrates that, in preparation for her call by God to be the Mother of His Son, God graced Mary from the first moment of her conception, when she was conceived without the stain of original sin. Since we celebrate her conception on December 8th, we celebrate her birthday nine months later on September 8th. Please note the change in our holyday schedule ... since we cannot celebrate a vigil Mass for the solemnity on Sunday, we will celebrate Mass tomorrow evening at 7:30 PM in addition to the regular Noon Mass.

In past years, Reconciliation Monday during Advent was held on the Monday before Christmas. This year, it has been moved a week earlier, so please come on Monday, December 15th as we join with the parishes of the Archdiocese of New York and the Brooklyn Diocese in providing an opportunity for confession before Christmas. Here at St. Luke priests will be available after the noon Mass until about 2:30 PM, and again in the evening from 7:00 to 9:00 PM. In the evening, there will also be the opportunity for Eucharistic Adoration as a way to prepare for confession, and then to praise God for the gift of forgiveness after you receive the sacrament. Eucharistic Adoration also gives us the chance to focus on the true reason for the season: Jesus Christ. Please extend an invitation to family members and neighbors who might wish to be reconciled with the Lord as a special Christmas gift to themselves this year.

As you know, Jessica Smith has been our Director of Music for many years and has extensive experience in the diocese and both personally and professionally. She works with adults and children here at St. Luke to provide beautiful and prayerful experiences of liturgy for our community. This afternoon at 2:30 PM, the choirs will be here in our church to provide an Advent concert to help us enter more fittingly into this beautiful season of hope and anticipation. I encourage you to show your support and appreciation by attending the concert. Bring neighbors and friends and help prepare your hearts for the way of the Lord. Who knows ... you might be inspired to join the choir yourself!
