There were many holiday activities last weekend here at St. Luke. Beginning on Thursday, the school had their Christmas concert. On Friday, the school sponsored Christmas shopping and the Athletic Association had their annual Christmas party. On Saturday we had a nice, cold evening for our Christmas tree lighting, and on Sunday our parish choirs provided a celebration of beautiful Advent hymns during their concert. We are blessed with many parish volunteers who provide activities for our school, arrange sports for our parish children, share their time and talents, and do so many things behind

the scenes to provide for our community at Christmas and throughout the year. Please say a prayer of gratitude for our fellow parishioners who do so much for our parish!

During this time of year, the Church focuses on issues regarding the end of time and the second coming of Jesus. Perhaps it also can give us a chance to think of our own end-of-life issues. My mom and I recently worked on our estates and other documents that will help to protect us if we become unable to care for ourselves. These documents are especially helpful if you are widowed or single, but I recommend speaking with your attorney to decide what is best for you.

#### Health Care Proxy and Living Will

With these documents you appoint someone to make decisions on your behalf if you are unable to communicate and you express clear instructions about whether you wish to prolong your life if you are diagnosed with an incurable injury or illness.

#### Power of Attorney

You designate someone to make legal and financial decisions on your behalf if you become unable to do so.

#### Last Will and Testament/Establishment of a Trust

Among other things, these documents determine how your assets will be distributed upon your death. In addition to naming family members, many people take the opportunity to designate charitable distributions as well. I ask you to please consider naming St. Luke Parish as a beneficiary as you plan your estate. Also, those over 70½ should know that tax-free gifts from retirement savings can be made to charitable institutions. Some seniors don't "need" their annual distribution (RMD) when they reach 73 and can reduce their tax burden by using those funds for charitable gifts.

#### Funeral Planning

Purchasing a cemetery plot, planning with a local funeral director, and making choices regarding funeral services can remove this burden from your family members and assure that your final wishes are respected. We find that sometimes family members decide to not have a funeral Mass on behalf of a loved one who regularly practiced the faith. Making your own plans can assure your wishes are carried out. Our parish website has resources for planning funeral liturgies.

The Third Sunday of Advent is known as Gaudete Sunday, and so we rejoice that these days will quickly lead us to the celebration of the birth of Jesus ... Maranatha ... come Lord Jesus!
