
Dear Friends,

I hope and pray that everyone had a blessed celebration of Christmas, and that many of us were able to spend time with family and friends. This time of year is filled with much joy and happiness as we gather with loved ones and reflect on the power of the Incarnation of Jesus. He is the Word made Flesh, and, when we attentively listen to the Word, we are comforted by our God and embraced by His love. Even if we are impacted by illness or mourning at this time of year, our faith sustains us and lifts us up.

On the Sunday after Christmas we celebrate the Holy Family of Jesus, Mary and Joseph. In today's passage from the second chapter of Matthew's gospel, we pick up the Nativity story from the departure of the magi. Joseph is warned in a dream that he needs to flee with Mary and Jesus to Egypt because Herod planned to put the child to death. After Herod died, the angel again spoke to Joseph in a dream and directed him to bring the Holy Family back to the land of Israel. One more visit from the angel in a dream led Joseph, Mary and Jesus to the region of Galilee to a town called Nazareth. It is in Nazareth where Jesus was raised, nourished, and educated by Mary and Joseph. The home in Nazareth became a precursor of the domestic church, since the love of Mary and Joseph helped to form and prepare Jesus for His public ministry years later. May our homes be a domestic church, where the love and mercy of God forms our children to be faithful Christians who follow the commandments to love God and to love our neighbor.

Later this week we prepare to begin a New Year. On January 1st each year the Church celebrates Mary, the Mother of God. How wonderful it is for us to begin each year honoring Mary and asking for her intercession as individuals and as a Church. One of the greatest ways to honor Mary is to pray the Rosary. I encourage all parishioners to pray the Rosary on your own or as a family. Many people will make resolutions for the New Year. Resolving to practice our faith first and foremost can be the impetus to make us successful in trying to achieve other resolutions for better health or personal growth. On behalf of the clergy and staff of the parish, I wish all parishioners and all those visiting us for the holidays a very blessed and happy New Year! May the New Year 2026 be filled with many graces and blessings for all of us! St. Luke, pray for us!
