

By the time December 25th rolls around, most people are “tired” of Christmas. Almost immediately local stores stock their shelves with gifts for Valentine’s Day, and most Christmas trees are brought to the curb for disposal shortly after New Year’s Day. For the Church, the Christmas season extends to the celebration of the Baptism of the Lord, which we celebrate this weekend. The baptism of Jesus took place when He was about 30 years of age, so chronologically it came many years after his birth. However, except for the finding of Jesus in the Temple as a child, He lived a private life in Nazareth until this time. The baptism of Jesus is really another epiphany, since the voice of the Father is heard from the heavens: “This is my beloved Son, with whom I am well pleased.” Now Jesus will begin his public ministry of proclaiming the kingdom and healing the sick, which will lead us into the Ordinary Time of the Church year.

We are happy to welcome Msgr. Strynkowski back to St. Luke this weekend. Since Bishop Chappetto is away for the month and I am away this weekend, I reached out to Monsignor to see if he could help out. I know parishioners are always happy to see him and are grateful for his inspiration and example. Msgr. Strynkowski, you are always welcome here at St. Luke!



For those of you who perhaps made a New Year’s resolution to pray more regularly, one suggestion I would make is iBreviary. iBreviary is most easily used as an app on an iPhone or android, but you can also access it on your computer at ibreviary.com. The breviary is another name for the Liturgy of the Hours, which is the official prayer of the Church. When deacons and priests make a promise to pray at their ordination, the promise entails faithfully praying the Liturgy of the Hours, which consecrates each day with Morning Prayer, Daytime Prayer, Evening Prayer, and Night Prayer. iBreviary makes it very easy to access those prayers each day, and it also provides the daily Mass readings. I personally use this app every day. iBreviary is hosted by a priest in Italy, and prayers are provided in several different languages. If you’d like to read the Bible in a year, I recommend Fr. Mike Schmitz’s podcast. I hope these resources are helpful!



Please remember that we have our Volunteer Thank You Party on Saturday, January 24th after the 4:30 PM Mass. Since Epiphany fell on the weekend before students returned to school, we thought that it would be better to schedule the party later in the month. I hope that parish ministers and volunteers will be able to attend so we can express our appreciation for your service to our community. The Parish Council will be hosting a Ministry Fair later this year, and I hope that many more parishioners will come forward to offer their time and talent to their brothers and sisters. Looking ahead, on March 7th the diocese will host another training workshop for lectors and Extraordinary Ministers of Holy Communion at the Mary Louis Academy. Please give some thought and prayer to possibly being trained to serve at St. Luke.


