As I write this the weather forecasters are expecting anywhere from nothing to almost two feet of snow this weekend! Up to now we've only had several "annoying" storms that required cleanup and salting on weekends and holidays, but winter might just make a dramatic return to Whitestone on this last weekend of January. Damian and Mauricio are so dedicated and make sure that our property is properly cleaned after these storms ... even Fr. Chin has joined them to help! I am truly grateful for all they do to keep our parish safe and accessible.

The last week of January is always celebrated as Catholic Schools Week. While the snow may alter our plans, we certainly appreciate the great leadership of Mrs. Jan Brunswick as principal of St. Luke School. Along with the faculty and staff, we are proud of the excellent education that is offered, and we appreciate the sacrifices made by parents to provide a Catholic education to their children. I encourage parishioners to spread the good news about St. Luke School and invite neighbors and friends to consider enrolling their children for next year.

Our school gym needed some repairs over the holiday weekend: tiles were removed and sheetrock was installed to repair the walls that were deteriorating due to age and use. One of the parish societies generously donated the funds to cover the cost. Some additional work was needed and the school is seeking some donations to offset the cost of completing the project. Thanks to all those who generously support our school and parish.

I received a letter from the Catholic Foundation for Brooklyn and Queens informing me of our parish goal for the 2026 Annual Catholic Appeal. The Pastors Advisory Committee reduced our goal to \$100,798.00. While, on one hand, we are happy that our goal was reduced, we have to realize that it has been reduced because our parish income has gone down. Our accountants recently provided me with the Financial Report for the fiscal year that ended on August 31, 2025, and I will soon share that report in the bulletin. We all know that costs go up, and, unless parish contributions also increase, it becomes harder and harder to administer the parish. I ask all parishioners to prayerfully consider increasing their weekly contributions. More than half of our parishioners contribute less than \$10 per week to the collection; for many people that doesn't cover the cost of one visit to Starbucks. In the five years I have been here I have increased my personal weekly offering to the parish at least two times. My prayer comes from the psalms: "How can I repay the Lord for all the great good done for me?" (Psalm 116:12) We are truly blessed in many ways; I encourage you to prayerfully consider how you can repay the Lord for the great good He has done for you.

For one last week, the gospel refers to St. John the Baptist. He has been arrested, and so Jesus begins his public ministry by calling the fishermen – Peter and Andrew, James and John: "Come after me, and I will make you fishers of men." As disciples of Jesus today, we must remember that we are called by the Lord to actively live our faith and share it with others.
