To those of you who “just love” winter ... thanks a lot! We had quite a storm last weekend, and it looks like we might get hit again this weekend. As always, everyone is encouraged to use your best judgment. Since there is no sure way to cancel Masses, I expect that we will always celebrate Mass when it snows. I’d hate to have people struggle to make it to church and then find the doors locked. As you can see by the numbers last weekend, a good number of people heeded the warnings and came to church on Saturday night before the storm. On Sunday, the roads became more prohibitive as the day progressed, and the numbers reflect that reality. On

these stormy days, try to make the Lord’s Day holy in the best way you can, and then curl up with a good book, get yourself a nice supply of yarn, bring out the family board games, or get ready to binge watch your favorite shows. Keep warm, stay safe, and we’ll see you in the spring!

Between the delayed printing and mailing of our offering envelopes and the harsh winter weather on weekends, our collections are down significantly compared to the past. Please make every effort to “catch up” on your offerings when you can safely return to church. You can write one check and put it in one envelope and mark it as a “catch up” offering. When you use the envelopes, it helps the counters if you write the amount of the offering on the front of the envelope and simply lick the adhesive to seal the envelope without using tape. Of course, our online platform, “Give Central,” can be used for your regular weekly donations or for occasional use through the year. On this Fourth Sunday in Ordinary Time, we turn to the fifth chapter of Matthew’s gospel for the Sermon on the Mount, featuring the Beatitudes. This teaching of Jesus is the framework for discipleship: we will struggle, but God will always be with us. Are you poor in spirit? Don’t worry – the kingdom of heaven is yours! Are you mourning? Be sure that God will comfort you! Are others uttering evil against you falsely? Your reward will be great in heaven! This fundamental teaching of Jesus comes at the beginning of the liturgical year so that it can become the foundation of our lives as disciples. Remember that you are blessed!

Tomorrow we have a quick return to Christmas with the **Presentation of the Lord**. Shortly after the birth of Jesus, Mary and Joseph brought the Child to the temple to present him to the Lord. Simeon holds the Child in his arms and thanks God for keeping His promise that Simeon would see the Messiah with his own eyes before he died. Even the prophetess, Anna, spoke about the child to all who were awaiting the redemption of Jerusalem. February 2nd is traditionally a day to bless candles that will be used for liturgies. Of course, February 3rd, the memorial of St. Blaise, is a day to used blessed candles to bless throats.


