On this Fifth Sunday in Ordinary Time we continue reading from the fifth chapter of Matthew's gospel. Jesus uses the common images of salt and light to encourage his disciples to live out and share their faith. If salt loses its taste you throw it out and trample it underfoot. Also, you don't waste a lamp by lighting it and then putting it under a bushel basket. We want to savor the taste of salt and let the light shine brightly. In the same way, we want our faith in Jesus to enrich our lives so that we do everything we can to share our faith with others. In the Second Vatican Council, we were

taught that all of us – not just clergy and those in consecrated life – are called to holiness. Spouses help and challenge one another in following the gospel. Parents teach their children to practice the faith. All of us are called to consider, "What would Jesus do?" in all that we say and do. These are great reflections for all of us as we prepare for Lent to begin in 10 days.



Next Sunday at the 12:30 Mass we will welcome the Pro Sanctity Movement for the celebration of Our Lady of Trust. Both Bishop Chappetto and I have been involved with the Apostolic Oblates and the Pro Sanctity Movement for many years. The Movement was founded by Servant of God Bishop Guglielmo Giaquinta after World War II, and he adopted Our Lady of Trust as the patroness of the Movement. He became devoted to this image of Mary when he was a seminarian in Rome because the image was featured in the seminary chapel. Mary is holding the Child Jesus, and He is pointing to His Mother's Immaculate Heart. The feast of Our Lady of Trust is celebrated on the Sunday before Lent begins, and her intercession accompanies us

in a special way through the forty days. There will be a light luncheon following the Mass in the Pastoral Center.

On Tuesday this week we celebrate the memory of St. Scholastica, the twin sister of St. Benedict, the founder of the Benedictine Order. St. Benedict founded his monastery on Monte Cassino and Scholastica founded a religious community a few miles away. They had the custom of visiting one another once a year in a farmhouse because the rule forbade them from meeting in either the convent or the monastery. They would engage in spiritual conversations during their visits. During her last visit with her brother, she pleaded with Benedict to continue their conversations through the night for she felt that her death was near. His own rule for the monastery did not allow him to stay out overnight, and so he refused. Scholastica paused for a moment of prayer, and suddenly a fierce storm roared outside the farmhouse. Benedict cried out, "God forgive you, Sister. What have you done?" Saint Scholastica replied, "I asked a favor of you and you refused. I asked it of God and he granted it." The twins are buried side by side in the monastery at Monte Cassino, and I have had the privilege of celebrating Mass there on two occasions during pilgrimages. St. Scholastica, pray for us!


