I hope you enjoyed the heat wave of the past week! It was nice to finally have some above-freezing temperatures. Pitchers and catchers reported this past week, and we are officially halfway through February, so we are making our way through winter 2026. For those of you who love the winter, I hope that Presidents Week will allow you to find all the snow you desire ... but far away from Whitestone! Monday is Presidents Day, and so Mass will be celebrated at 9:30 AM instead of at Noon, and the rectory office will be closed until Tuesday.

Lent begins on Ash Wednesday, which is this coming Wednesday, February 18th.

On this final Sunday before Lent, we continue to read from the fifth chapter of Matthew's gospel. Jesus announces to the crowd gathered for his Sermon on the Mount: "I have come not to abolish but to fulfill (the law and the prophets)." This teaching is confirmed at the Transfiguration, when Jesus appears with Moses and Elijah on Mount Tabor. Every year on the Second Sunday of Lent we read the passage of the Transfiguration from one of the synoptic gospels, so this week's passage prepares us for what is to come in two weeks. In today's passage Jesus goes beyond the letter of the law. When it comes to the commandments, we can easily rationalize our actions and excuse away our sins. Jesus says, "You have heard that it was said to your ancestors, You shall not kill; and whoever kills will be liable to judgment. But I say to you, whoever is angry with his brother will be liable to judgment." The commandment to not kill goes beyond physical death, so Jesus warns his disciples and all of us that we should follow the commandment to love.

As Lent begins this week, we have the typical devotions and services planned during this holy season: Italian Stations of the Cross on Monday evenings; Lenten Journey with Jesus on Tuesdays; English Stations of the Cross on Fridays after the noon Mass. During the season we will plan our Soup Supper; we will welcome back Creative Ministries for their production of Journey, Cross and Crucifixion, and we will show the movie Triumph of the Heart, which is based on the story of St. Maximilian Kolbe during World War II. As always, confessions are available on Saturdays from 3:15 to 4:15 PM, and on Reconciliation Monday during Holy Week. The Diocese of Brooklyn is once again organizing a Lenten Pilgrimage to different parishes in Brooklyn and Queens for each day of Lent. I encourage you to give some prayerful consideration for your own spiritual growth during this holy season. Our Lady of Trust, pray for us!
