“Rejoice, Jerusalem, and all who love her. Be joyful, all who were in mourning; exult and be satisfied at her consoling breast.”

The Fourth Sunday of Lent marks a turning point in the season. The entrance antiphon tells us to “rejoice” in the midst of this penitential season. The Latin word for “rejoice” in the antiphon is *lætare*, and so this Sunday is also known as *Lætare Sunday*. Priests have the option of wearing rose colored vestments today to visibly manifest that we are making progress through the forty days and will soon celebrate the joy of Easter.

We once again turn to John’s Gospel for our reading today and hear the story of the man born blind. Unlike other healing stories, the blind man makes no request for healing from Jesus. Jesus says to his disciples: “it is so that the works of God might be made visible through him ... while I am in the world, I am the light of the world.” The blind man is sent to go wash in the Pool of Siloam, and he returns able to see. Of course, we are washed clean in the waters of baptism and are restored to grace through the Eucharist and the Sacrament of Penance. Once we are washed clean, we can see! Jesus, the light of the world, guides us out of darkness not only during the forty days of Lent, but any time we avail ourselves of the grace of the sacraments.

This week we celebrate two great saints: on March 17th we celebrate St. Patrick, and on March 19th we celebrate St. Joseph. Of course, we anticipated our celebration of St. Patrick with our Irish Heritage Event last weekend. I am grateful to Lisa Scardamaglia, Deirdre Zuccarello, and all those who assisted them in keeping that great tradition alive. On Thursday we celebrate the Solemnity of St. Joseph, which gives us a little reprieve during Lent. While St. Joseph travelled no further than Egypt, Italy has adopted St. Joseph as a special patron, and so special pastries – *singi and zeppole* - are traditional treats to celebrate his feast. *St. Patrick and St. Joseph ... pray for us!*

Every year during Lent our Parish Youth Group sponsors a soup supper. The purpose of a soup supper is to share a simple meal that allows us to generously provide for those who are less fortunate. While there is no cost for the soup supper, a basket for free-will offerings will be provided so that we can support the Soup Kitchen at St. Michael.

Remember that we will host *Journey, Cross and Crucifixion* on Wednesday, March 25th at 7:30 PM. The evening session of our Religious Education program will attend, as well as the Conirmandi from our school. All parishioners are most welcome to come and pray the Stations of the Cross in a very moving and prayerful way.

Little by little more people are returning to church after a tough winter. I am truly grateful to everyone who has “made up” their offerings either through the mail or by bringing the envelopes to church when you are able. Thank you!
