While we have been in Ordinary Time since May 25th, this is our first "Sunday in Ordinary Time," since the Solemnities of the Holy Trinity and the Holy Body and Blood of Christ followed Pentecost Sunday. So, this is the 11th Sunday in Ordinary Time, and we return to our reading of Matthew's Gospel since this is Year A in the cycle of Sunday readings. In today's passage Jesus calls the Twelve and gives them authority over unclean spirits and to drive them out and to cure every disease and every illness. Obviously the Twelve were close associates of Jesus who were given the responsibility of forming the Church after

Jesus ascended into heaven, but this passage reminds us that all of us are called by Jesus to put our faith into action according to our talents and abilities. A second grader can share with a classmate. An eighth grader can help support a friend who is being bullied. A high schooler can provide tutoring to classmates who are struggling. Adults can volunteer at a soup kitchen, help provide food and clothing to the needy, and serve the community in a liturgical ministry. All of us are called to be stewards of our time, talent, and treasure, and what a blessing it is to make a return to the Lord for all the good He does for us!

Speaking of stewardship, last week I included a financial report of our parish for the last fiscal year, which ended in August 2025. Our accountant prepared the full report for the diocese in the fall, and we synthesized it in a way to easily share with the community, but we just realized that we failed to publish it at that time. I apologize for the delay.

We had a very busy week. Last weekend we had our Corpus Christi procession on Saturday evening, and our choirs put on a wonderful concert on Sunday afternoon. We celebrated a graduation Mass for our eighth graders on Wednesday, and the commencement exercises were held on Friday. God bless the St. Luke School Class of 2026! We wish them well as they transition to high school in the fall. I hope they always will see our parish as their home, and I certainly encourage them to continue to practice their faith here at St. Luke. St. Luke School will conclude the academic year on Thursday, and we pray for a happy and restful summer for all.

Of course, this weekend we are celebrating the five years of priestly ministry of Fr. Chin. We have been truly blessed by his kindness, generosity, compassion, and faith. He has left a special mark on the young people of the parish. He knows so many of them by name, and they have come to love him in their interactions with him in the classroom, on the sport field, in the church, and in the community. He has been actively engaged in all aspects of parish life, he celebrated the sacraments with great love and devotion, and parishioners of all ages have been inspired by his goodness and his witness to Jesus. He worked well with the staff and was a blessing to live with in the rectory. He will be missed! We pray that God will continue to bless him as he begins his new assignment at St. Gregory the Great and Queensborough Community College. God bless you Fr. Chin! We love you!
