This weekend we are happy to welcome Fr. Stephen Ackah to St. Luke. Fr. Steve is a priest from Ghana who has served in summer assignments in our diocese for the past few years. In addition to parish ministry, he has also been involved with priestly formation work as a teacher



of philosophy. He is very happy to have this opportunity to minister here at St. Luke, and I know that you will join me in welcoming him and making him feel at home here in Whitestone. Next weekend he will preach at all the Masses to have the chance to introduce himself to the community so we can get to know him. **Welcome to St. Luke Fr. Steve!**



Every year during the summer the Office of the Propagation of the Faith of the Diocese of Brooklyn arranges for mission appeals to take place in our parishes. It is our privilege and responsibility not only to pray for Catholic missionaries around the world, but also to encourage and sustain them with our generous financial support. This year we are happy to welcome the Most Reverend Mel Rey Uy, the Bishop of the Diocese of Lucena in the Philippines. Between 75-80% of households in the Philippines identify as Roman Catholic, and our diocese is blessed with many immigrants from the Philippines who are very prominent and active members of our parishes. A second collection will be taken up at all Masses this weekend to allow our parish to contribute to the spreading of the Good News of Jesus in the Diocese of Lucena. **Welcome Bishop Uy!**

On this first weekend of August, we celebrate the 18th Sunday in Ordinary Time. In today's gospel we hear the story of the miracle of the loaves and the fish. Jesus is mourning the death of John the Baptist and wants to spend some time alone. The crowds follow him, and He is moved with pity for them and cures the sick. He spends the whole day with them, and the disciples encourage Jesus to send the people home so they can find food for themselves. Instead, Jesus uses the moment to show God's generous and abundant care for His people. Jesus blesses the five loaves and two fish, and suddenly there is so much food available that there are twelve baskets left over when all have eaten their fill. The gospel this weekend allows us to recognize the many blessings that God generously shares with us, and our call as disciples to share what we have received with our brothers and sisters in need.

On Tuesday we celebrate the memorial of St. John Vianney, the patron of priests. Please pray for the priests who have ministered to you and your family over the years, and please pray for the priests of St. Luke, asking for his intercession for us as we minister to this parish family. Wednesday is the memorial of Our Lady of the Snows, a miracle that led to the establishment of the Basilica of St. Mary Major in Rome. On Thursday we celebrate the Transfiguration, a reminder for us that Jesus came to fulfill the Law and the Prophets. The Church blesses us with these wonderful celebrations as we reach the mid-point of the summer!
