Dear Friends.

I welcome all our visitors, neighbors, and friends to St. Luke as we begin Holy Week with our celebration of Palm Sunday. Many of you live locally here in Whitestone but don't often worship with us. Know that you are welcome, and that we encourage you to join us every week at Mass on Saturday evening or Sunday. It is important to regularly listen to God's Word, be nourished by Jesus in the Eucharist, and to pray with fellow Christians as we all strive to be authentic disciples of the Lord.

Monday of Holy Week is Reconciliation Monday. Our parish will join parishes across Long Island, New York City, and even the communities as far north as Poughkeepsie in having priests available for the Sacrament of Penance for a good part of the day. Here at St. Luke we will have two priests available after the noon Mass for as long as we are needed, and then we will have Exposition of the Blessed Sacrament at 6:00 PM with a priest available for confession until 9:00 PM, when we will have Benediction. Other parishes will be open from 2:00 to 4:00 PM; we have the custom of making confession more convenient for those who attend the noon Mass by having confessions right after that Mass. Whether you last went to confession one week ago or 40 years ago, know that you are welcome to receive the Lord's grace and mercy in this wonderful sacrament of forgiveness. *Turn away from sin and be faithful to the gospel!*

On Tuesday of Holy Week, Bishop Brennan will lead the diocese in his first Chrism Mass as the Bishop of Brooklyn. During that Mass, he will bless the oils that are used in the sacraments celebrated throughout the diocese over the next year. We will welcome those oils to St. Luke during the Mass of the Lord's Supper on Holy Thursday.

On Wednesday of Holy Week, we will show Mel Gibson's *The Passion of the Christ* in the Monsignor Tosi Parish Center. The film is recorded in the ancient languages used at the time of Christ, but the sub-titles are provided in English. It follows the story of the Passion from the gospels and from devotional writings of the visions of Anne Catherine Emmerich. At times, the film is very gruesome as it depicts the scourging and other aspects of the Passion, but I have found it to be an excellent way to prepare for the Triduum, which ultimately brings us to the glory of the Resurrection. After the film, we will take time for discussion or reflections if there is any interest. All are welcome.

The schedule for the Triduum is found on the cover of today's bulletin. This year we will have a bi-lingual celebration of the Lord's Passion on Good Friday at 3:00 PM led by Bishop Chappetto. The Borgetto Association is sponsoring the Good Friday procession for the Italian community again this year starting at St. Mel at 7:00 PM. In the evening of Good Friday here at St. Luke we will pray the Stations of the Cross at 8:00 PM with the opportunity to venerate the cross afterwards. Due to COVID, veneration of the cross is limited to either a bow/genuflection before the cross, or a simple touch of the cross instead of kissing the cross. I pray that a modified return to individual veneration of the cross will be appreciated by those who regularly come to Good Friday celebrations.

May God richly bless us all during this Holy Week! Fr. John Costello
